





Local Government (Functions and General) Regulations 1996 and specifically Regulation 11A which states:

11A.Purchasing policies for local governments

- (1) A local government is to prepare or adopt, and is to implement, a purchasing policy in relation to contracts for other persons to supply goods or services where the consideration under the contract is, or is expected to be, \$250 000 or less or worth \$250 000 or less.*
- (2) A purchasing policy is to make provision for and in respect of the policy to be followed by the local government for, and in respect of, entering into contracts referred to in subregulation (1).*
- (3) A purchasing policy must make provision in respect of—*
 - (a) the form of quotations acceptable; and*
 - (ba) the minimum number of oral quotations and written quotations that must be obtained; and*

(b)the recording and retention of written information, or documents, in respect of —

(i)all quotations received; and

(ii)all purchases made.





- (1) Subject to subsection (2), the following are to be open to members of the public —

 - (b) all meetings of any committee to which a local government power or duty has been delegated.
- (2) If a meeting is being held by a council or by a committee referred to in subsection (1)(b), the council or committee may close to members of the public the meeting, or part of the meeting, if the meeting or the part of the meeting deals with any of the following —
 - (a) a matter affecting an employee or employees; and
 - (c) a contract entered into, or which may be entered into, by the local government and which relates to a matter to be discussed at the meeting; and
- (3) A decision to close a meeting or part of a meeting and the reason for the decision are to be recorded in the minutes of the meeting.
