4. General Business

C Scally Is there an update from last year on the skate park improvements?

President We had an amount allocated in the budget under town scaping, unfortunately due

to other infrastructure projects, we were unable to progress with improvements

last year.

K Storer We were successful in receiving a grant for Town Teams through RAC. A project

at the skate park has been included within that and we will have a graphic artist

coming up in April to work with the Youth Group to paint the ramps and jumps.

C Scally Is it possible to use the Memorial Hall more as money has been spent doing it up?

Is it possible to look at having the ANZAC Day morning tea in there?

President We are yet to commence planning for the 2024 ANZAC Day, but we will look into

it when the time comes pending the weather forecast. We have had feedback that

the hall is a big room for a small gathering, but it is always an option.

C Scally Is there an update on the Recreation Centre upgrade? Will the show and Winter

Sports go ahead?

President In line with the last reporting period, there were delays with the steel

manufacturers, and that was the main reason for the delays. We have been full steam ahead since September/October. There will be an impact for Winter Sports as they can't use the facilities, but we are hoping to have a meeting with the Winter

Sports Presidents to work to reduce any impacts.

C Scally Is the Bowling Green still set to move?

President In last reporting period it was noted there was potential to move, as there was

room in the plans that allowed this. Council is set to make a decision in March this

year.

C Scally Is the car at the medical centre available for Koorda residents to use for medical

appointments? One resident has to get someone from Corrigin to drive them to

and from medical appointments outside of town.

President We are yet to hear back about our enquiries from last year.

K. Storer People who received home care packages are able to use this funding for

transportation to and from medical appointments. The CRC looked into this, and we are aware that Gingin has a community car. They have a roster of 5-6 drivers

as they have a larger population. We may find it hard to secure volunteer drivers.

C Scally I see there was referral to a Eucalypt Woodlands Project in the annual report.

Where is this project and when is it being undertaken?

President A Development Application was received for a part of Drumin Farm, along the salt

flats out of town, along the Koorda-Kulja Road. The applicant has two years to

commence the project.

C Scally There has been issues with the TV reception for the past week, is there an update

available?

President Unfortunately we do not currently know what the problem is. We will have to take

the question on notice and encourage you to come into the office and speak to the

staff about it, where we should have more of an update to provide.
