WYALKATCHEM MEDICAL CENTRE & KOORDA **HEALTH CENTRE UPDATE**

In mid-March the Shire of Wyalkatchem advised that the Medical Board was scheduled to consider their endorsement of a trained and experienced doctor who had been recruited to work from the Medical Centres in Wyalkatchem & Koorda.

Unfortunately, the Medical Board has not endorsed the identified candidate, despite the candidate having worked in Australia as a doctor for over 6 years and highlights the very high standards the Medical Board sets for recruitment of doctors into regional areas where doctors are required to work largely autonomously and with limited support.

The recruitment process has been restarted.

In the meantime, GP services from the Medical Centres will continue to be provided via telehealth, supplemented with a site visit to the Wyalkatchem Medical Centre by Dr Emmanuel Awogun, every second Thursday.

It is hoped with travel restrictions into WA relaxed and access to a larger pool of doctors now available that this renewed recruitment effort will be guicker & more successful

Easing of public health measures

Effective 12.01am Thursday, 31 March 2022

Masks:



The mask requirement remains in place for all regions across Western Australia.

Masks must be worn at all indoor public settings for those in Year 3 and over, unless exempt.

Gatherings:



Indoor home gatherings limited to 30 people (including household members).



Private outdoor gatherings limited to 200 people. If outdoors at a private residence, the 2 square metre rule applies.

Entertainment venues:



- Proof of vaccination requirement
- 75% capacity limit for seated entertainment venues such as theatres and cinemas.



- 2 square metre capacity rule at Perth Crown Complex, including the gaming floor
- Increased 500-person capacity limit at convention and function centres - which will be removed on 14 April 2022

Schools:



- Masks required for all staff and students in Year 3 and over
- Proof of vaccination requirements in place for staff and regular visitors

Events at major stadiums:



- **Proof of vaccination requirement**
- 75% capacity limit in place for RAC Arena, Optus Stadium, HBF Stadium (Main Arena), and HBF Park

Venues & businesses:



Proof of vaccination requirements in place for a range of venues, businesses and events



2 square metre capacity rule in place for some venues such as hospitality, galleries and museums, places of worship, hairdressers and beauty salons



Increased 500-person capacity limit at nightclubs and hospitality venues - which will be removed on 14 April 2022



COVID-safe settings in workplaces remain to manage workforce impacts

Fitness venues and community sport:



2 square metre capacity limit and proof of vaccination requirement at fitness venues such as gyms, pilates, yoga and dance studios



- Indoor community sport: masks and venue requirements apply
- Outdoor community sport: no spectator limit

Health & care facilities:



Hospitals:

- Masks mandatory for staff and visitors
- Visitor limits apply
- Proof of vaccination required for visitors

Aged and disability care:

- Masks mandatory for staff and visitors
- Limit of two visitors per resident per day
- Proof of vaccination required for visitors to aged care facilities

Entry to remote Aboriginal communities remains restricted, as necessary.
