SHIRE OF KOORDA WELCOMES OVER \$3MILLION INVESTMENT IN BUILDINGINFRASTRUCTURE IN MARCH/APRIL 2023

In March and April 2023, the Shire's administration processed approvals that will result in over \$3 million worth of building infrastructure to our community.

After 8 years in planning and development, the most significant investment in both dollar terms and scale is the establishment of a 24-person workers accommodation facility by the CBH Group at 1 Orchard St, Koorda (opposite the drive-in).

In addition to the workers' accommodation, the facility comprises kitchen, laundry, ablutions, and common room areas.

Nearly \$1 million of telecommunication improvements has also been approved which will see Optus construct and commission a new cell tower in Mollerin, Telstra construct a new cell tower in the Koorda townsite, and CRISP Wireless will erect a new fixed wireless internet tower in Newcarlbeon.

It is envisaged that these telecommunication improvement projects will provide for industry competition and enhanced voice and data communications for the local community.

A1 WHEATBELT DOG RESCUE

ADVICE OF BUILDING DELAY – KOORDA RECREATION GROUND PAVILION UPGRADE AND EXTENSION

At its meeting held on 15 December 2022, and following a public and community group/sports club consultation process, the Shire of Koorda (Shire) Council accepted a design and construction tender from Stallion Homes Pty Ltd (Stallion) for the Koorda Recreation Ground Pavilion extension and upgrade, funded predominantly by the Federal Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program (LRCIP).

During the process of awarding the tender and preparing construction drawings, the Shire and Stallion were planning on construction works commencing in the first half of 2023.

However, due to the significant labour and building material challenges facing the building and construction industry, generally, and, in our case, the provision of construction steel, specifically, Stallion have advised the Shire that the commencement of building works will be delayed until September 2023.

Whilst the delay to September 2023 will allow for an uninterrupted Koorda Winter Sports season, the Shire apologises for the inconvenience to the community groups/sporting clubs that will be affected once building works commence.

It is also important to note that the building delay will not affect the Shire's LRCIP funding as the labour and building material challenges facing the building and construction industry has resulted in an extension to the project timelines under this program.

UNAUTHORISED DRIVING ON THE GOLF COURSE
