Under the agreement, Koorda would have a visiting medical practitioner for two consecutive days each week.

The new agreement comes as the previous medical practitioner suddenly terminated his services, effective last Friday.

The Shire will keep the community updated to any changes to the new service, including the start date and if a locum service can be secured in the interim.
