LIBRARY NEWS

If you are not a member of the library, signing up is easy and FREE and will also give you access to the FREE e resources such as Borrow Box, Libby, Kanopy and Hoopla. Ask staff at the counter about joining up or call the office during opening times and we can send you details to join the library.



REMINDER – DOG AND CAT REGISTRATIONS

Dog and cat registrations are due for renewal on the 31st of October each year. If you are unsure if your pet is due for renewal this year, please call the office on 9684 1219 for staff to confirm. Alternatively, you can check the year on the registration tag. As of the 31st of May the registrations are half price.

Do you have a pet that needs to be registered? State Government regulations require that all dogs over three months of age need to be registered and microchipped. Cats over six months of age need to be microchipped, sterilised and registered.

Please note that owners of unregistered animals can incur an on-the-spot fine of \$200 by Council Rangers.
