The shire is arranging for more of the bin covers currently along Railway Street.

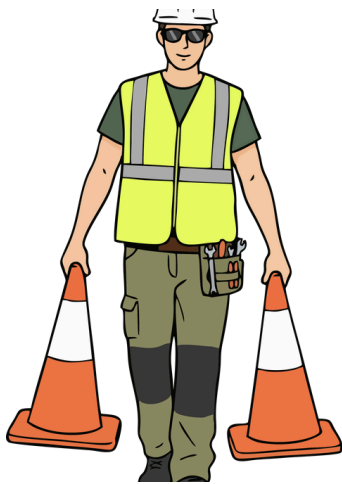

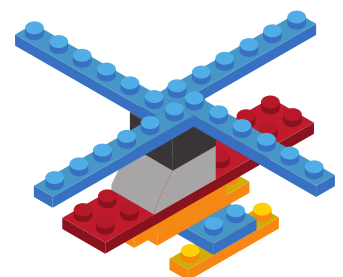
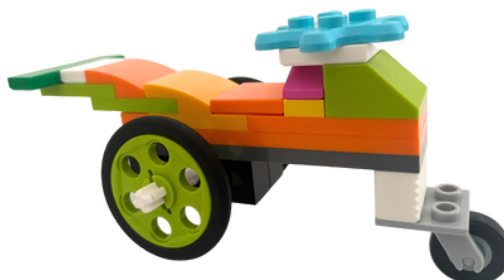
