Who we are:

The Koorda Shire is in the north-eastern Wheatbelt about 240km from Perth and half an hour driving from nearby towns. The predominate industry is agriculture (wheat and sheep) and the main town includes a primary school, free-of-charge swimming pool, supermarket, community gym and thriving sports community.

What you get:

The total remuneration package is up to \$85,770.

It comprises a base salary of \$66,750 and superannuation up to 24% with a \$400 clothing allowance and \$50/week rent assistance.

The position also has the option of a Shire house with rent currently at \$110.00 per week.

Work hours are 8am to 4.30pm weekdays with 22 days annual leave and a rostered day off every four weeks.

Please note water leaks are to be reported to the Water Corporation and not through the Shire Administration Office. Often the Water Corp Operator will ask the reporter questions relating to the leak that Shire Staff may not have the answer to. If you spot a leak, you can report it by phoning 13 13 75. Faults can also be reported via the Water Corporation's website.
