Community Emergency Services Manager

An opportunity exists to make a critical and strategic contribution in emergency services for three Wheatbelt shires which cover an area of more than 1.6 million hectares.

The shires of Koorda, Mt Marshall and Mukinbudin, in partnership with the Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES), are seeking a community minded self-starter to take up the position of Community Emergency Services Manager based at Koorda about 235km from the Perth CBD.

The successful candidate will need high level communication and interpersonal skills and well-developed leadership, management and administrative abilities. Ideally, they will also have experience in fire and emergency services and knowledge of Bush Fire Brigades and Local Government.

Primarily the role will manage the delivery and implementation of preparedness, prevention, response and recovery services, for bush fire, in the shires of Koorda, Mt Marshall and Mukinbudin. It will require developing effective partnerships that adopt a best practice approach to emergency management delivery between the shires, DFES, Volunteer Bush Fire Brigades and the community.

It will require a good knowledge of fire mitigation, an ability to develop fire management planning processes and undertake prescribed burning. A current qualification in Training and Assessment and Level 1 Incident Controller – Bushfire Hazard would be highly regarded. The position will also have an operational component in emergency response and will require availability on weekends and outside normal business hours as required, as well as an on-call roster for which an allowance is paid.

Offered is a total salary package of circa \$123,000 per annum comprising:

- Base salary of \$95,000
- Availability Allowance of \$12,437
- Employer Superannuation Contribution: 12%
- Annual Leave 20 days per annum with 17.5% leave loading
- Uniform Allowance: \$800 per annum
- Tools of Trade: Fully maintained vehicle, laptop and mobile phone
- Accommodation: Subsidised rent (max. rent \$180pw)

\$100 FUEL SUPPORT PAYMENT – PAPER APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE

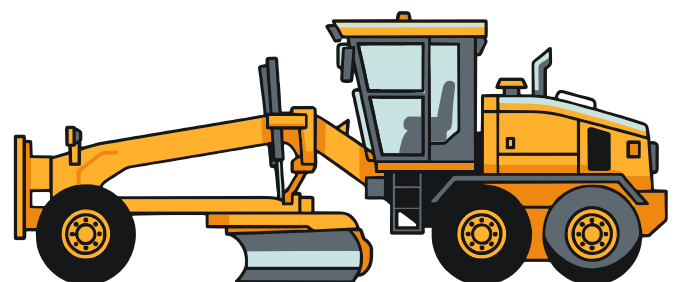
The \$100 Fuel Support Payment is now available for all eligible Western Australian driver's licence holders. The quickest and easiest way to claim is through the ServiceWA app.

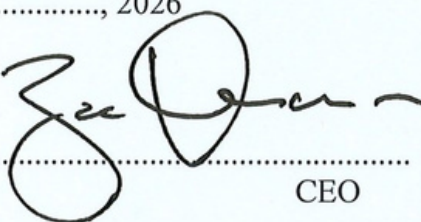

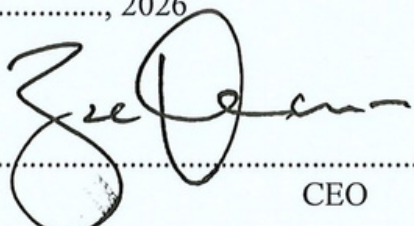
